

Attention Camping Guests:

Our first priority is the safety and well-being of our campers, as well as ourselves.

Social distancing must be observed. This means no gatherings of more than 10 per site and maintaining a 6 foot distance (unless household unit member). Cloth face masks should be worn if not able to social distance.

Due to the COVID19 pandemic, there are currently limited amenities at our campground. Currently the restrictions we have are:

- **Self-contained camping unit sites available, limited pop-up / tent sites**
- A log of guests' names, site and date must be kept
- Covid acknowledgement statement must be signed at registration
- Bathroom / shower facilities are open and sanitized and cleaned daily. We recommend masks, especially on weekends. Do not wait inside facilities
- Reduced playground access – please bring your own buckets / shovels for the sandbox
- Swimming pool – open with max swimmer limits, log-in required, bring your own seating
- Pavilion access – offers outdoor seating, tables spaced
- Rec Hall – open limited hours, masks required

There are no group activities for the time being, including but not limited to themed weekend activities.

Our store is now also housing our office. The store is offering limited items:

Ice, firewood, AquaChem

Propane tanks filled

Some candy, cold drinks, ice cream and snacks

Basic non-perishable groceries

BWC wear and some RV supplies

We suggest you wear gloves when hooking up to water, electric and when using our dump station.

This situation remains fluid and we will make updates as needed. We are and will continue to following the guidelines of NY State, County and federal Government, as well as the CDC.
